NOTE FOR PARENTS

- To ensure that the students reaches well in time daily.
- To inform the school immediately in writing if there is any change in the address and telephone number.
- To check the haircut, uniform and punctuality of your ward in the morning. Nail Paint/ henna/ artificial hair colour are not allowed.
- To see that your ward carries books/ exercise books according to the time table for that day. No extra books should be there so as to manage beg weight.
- Parents should ensure that all material required for class activities and competition is sent on the date specified.
- Parents should check the daily home assignments of their wards.
- If your ward is absent from school, he/ she must make up for all the work missed by him/ her.
- Encourage your ward to take a balanced interest in studies, co- curricular activities and sports.
- No fancy accessories (clips, watches, dangling, ear-rings, bangles, nail paint, hair styling) allowed.
- Give healthy food & snacks, no messy food, no maggi, no sauce, no pickle, send only oil free healthy nutritious meal.
- Pin a neat handkerchief to the uniform. Identi-card is must.
- Keep all circular and worksheet in a folder.
- A nutritious and wholesome tiffin from home is recommended.
- Your ward should be instructed to be careful about his/ her belongings. There should be a name tag on blazers, sweaters, water bottles and lunch boxes.
- It is always advisable to inform the school about the problems of your ward or seeking guidance. Your letters will be replied to, after discussion with the teachers concerned.
- A sick child should not be sent to school. An application, along with the medical certificate, Should be sent at the earliest.
- Encourage your ward to develop a healthy attitude towards the community and the Nation.
- Every Student is expected to maintain an attendance record of at least 75% During the academic year.
- Please do not give mobile phone to your child. If any student is found carrying a mobile phone, it will be confiscated and a fine of Rs 500/- will be imposed. Also Mobile phone will not be returned till the end of academic session.

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- Our Expectations -

1. To impart the best in education to child , maximum co – operation between parents and school authorities is desired. Parents are requested to look into their child's school diary everyday and ensure that lesson, and home –work assigned for the day is done properly. The child should be encouraged to cultivate study habits and develop self confidence . Remarks made in the diary should be seen and counter signed regularly and taken seriously in a constructive way. No critical remark about the school/ teacher's observation should be made in diary. However way. The parents may meet principal to discuss separately.
2. If a Parents feels that his/ her child is not making the desired progress, he/ she should meet the principal and take advice.
3. Criticism of the teachers and of the school in word's presence should be avoided . It causes the child to lose respect for the teachers / school , which hampers the child's progress and personality . The child should be encouraged to develop a positive attitude by giving him positive experience and avoid criticism. Parents and teachers are the partners in making a child's future.
4. Children learn more from what they see and hear- therefore , one should be careful In behavior , action and speech, particularly in the presence of children.
5. Leave for half day will not be permitted.
6. Parents must ensure that their ward does not bring objectionable books , magazines , photos or cell- phones/ tabs etc. To school as these are strictly prohibited and shall be seized if found . Parents are not allowed to enter classroom or meet the class teachers while teaching.

Non- Attendance-

1. A child who has been absent will not be permitted to sit in the class without an application from the parent addressed to the class teachers , stating the reason of absence.
2. Make it point to attend Parent-Teacher meet to keep a track of your child's progress. The attendance of Parent-Teacher meeting will be marked.
3. Any change in the date of the parents teachers meeting is intimated to the parent through the student dairy/SMS. Kindly check SMS daily & co-operate school.
4. A students , returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should produce a doctor's fitness certificate permitting him/her to do so.

Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class-

| a. Chicken Pox | Till complete falling of the scabs |
| b. Cholera | Till the child is completely well. |
| c. Measles | Two Week after the rash disappears. |
| d. Mumps | Unit the swelling has gone , about one month. |
| e. Whooping Cough | Six Weeks. |
| f. Jaundice | Six Week after recovery. |

Late Arrival In School-

1. The students should reach school 5 mins. Before the first bell.
2. The school gate will be closed at the first bell. Late arrivals will not be allowed to attend the school and repeated defaulters will be sent back home.
3. Parents have to sign the ' Record of Late Arrival ' in the almanac.
